Rules and Regulations

1. All contestants must have reached their 18th birthday, with valid Government Issue I.D. Anyone is eligible to compete; all applicants must be a member of Campit Outdoor Resort.
2. You must submit a completed application along with a \$20.00 entry fee for amateurs and \$25.00 entry fee for professionals. All entry fees must be paid to Campit. Under no circumstance will a contestant be allowed to compete unless their entry fee is paid in full. This entry fee includes your \$10.00 seasonal membership fee.
3. All contestants must be present and on time for registration on August 07, 2009 at the Campit Resort office, located at 6635 118th Avenue, Fennville, Michigan at 5pm. Registration will move as quickly as possible to allow you to be back at Westwood clubhouse by 7:30 pm. The contest will begin at 8:00 pm sharp. Any contestant late for registration or not back at the campground by the appropriate time will lose administration points. If something unforeseen should happen, you must contact September Murphy (616-856-6977). NO ONE ELSE WILL BE ABLE TO WAIVE THE ADMINISTRATION POINTS.
4. At registration, we will be collecting music for swimwear and talent.

Categories

Professional and Amateur

Talent: You will be limited to 5 minutes. You will be given 2 minutes to set up props and 2 minutes to break down props. If you use no props, no extra time will be allowed. This category is worth 100 points per judge.

No fire or live animal acts will be allowed. Music must be on a CD. The CD must also be scratch free. Please do not label your music as we will do that at registration. The DJ will not mix music.

Contestants will return the following day to perform at Campit's Annual Mardi Gras Celebration on Saturday August 08, 2009.

The winner and first alternate will be asked to perform at our Labor Day Talent Show also. September 5, 2009. This is a paid booking.
